Bruce Highway, Boundary Road to Bribie Island Road Landscaping

The Department of Transport and Main Roads will be landscaping the centre median on the Bruce Highway between Boundary Road and Bribie Island Road, from 11 April to mid-2011, weather permitting.

Work will involve replacing most of the existing grass with native trees, shrubs and clumping grasses to improve the scenery and reduce maintenance requirements.

To give the new plants the best chance of establishing and prevent them from being smothered, a herbicide will be applied to the existing grass before replanting begins. The centre median may look brown and unattractive until the new plants have established.

To minimise impacts to motorists, work will generally be undertaken at night between **6 pm and 6 am, Sunday to Thursday**. Some work may be required outside of these times.

Motorists may experience traffic disruptions during this work. Lane closures, reduced speed limits, traffic controllers and construction signage will be in place to safeguard motorists and road workers.
